Taqueria del Sol has a reputation for flavorful, made-from-scratch Southern, Mexican and Southwestern dishes. In 2007, Bon Appétit even named it a “Top American restaurant.” Stand in line, order, take a seat and wait hungrily for one of the restaurant’s famous tacos (choose from smoked pork, brisket, fried chicken, carnita, fish and veggie), or enchiladas (cheese, brisket, refried bean or roasted chicken). You also can’t go wrong with one of the restaurant’s delicious soups and chilis. We like the beef red chili, a simple, but delicious blend of ground beef, onions, green bell peppers, tomatoes, Guajillo chile and saltine crackers, but shrimp corn chowder and pork green chili are equally delicious. They’ll warm your belly, they’ll warm your soul—especially when washed down with a yummy margarita.
